**1. President's Report**

## AGENDA DELEGATES' COUNCIL MEETING TUESDAY 15 APRIL 2014

A draft of the letter to Recfishwest from the Association about the Herring Stock Status was given to all Delegates prior to the meeting. It was discussed at length with several suggestions received from the floor of the meeting and incorporated. A copy of the final document is to be distributed to Delegates.

Russell Bunce noted that there was a ban on commercial activities over the Easter weekend in the Cape to Cape region. This was implemented approximately 10 years ago. He asked why, if the authorities could do this for one weekend, why couldn't it be implemented for each weekend during the salmon season to allow recreational anglers a chance at catching some salmon.

### **Tell Us Why You Like Fishing and Win**

A copy of a leaflet from Recfishwest was handed out to delegates about the research project being undertaken at Curtin University. Professor Alexandra McManus and her Team are asking anglers to complete a survey "*Tell Us Why You Like Fishing and Win*". Delegates were requested to pass the information about the survey to club members to complete. Survey is at [www.surveymonkey.com/s/recfishing](http://www.surveymonkey.com/s/recfishing). If they leave their contact details at the end of the survey there is a chance of winning a boat rod valued at \$350.00 and a reel valued at \$150.00. It is sponsored and supported by Recfishwest, and will provide important information to the researchers to benefit recreational anglers. The survey needs to be completed by the end of May 2014.

Department of Fisheries have updated the Recreational Fishing Guide to 13 March 2014. It incorporates a number of changes.

If you are booking a site at the Yallingup Caravan Park mention that you there for the AAWA Fishing Competition and they will try to keep all of us together.

Trophies are set to go, a few were left over from the Estuary Rock & Beach and they will be recycled back into the system.
